

**Konawaena High School Wall of Fame
Criteria for Selection
Developed by Konawaena Foundation (4/11/08)**

Wall of Fame Purpose: The purpose of the Konawaena High School Wall of Fame is to recognize outstanding graduates for their achievements and contributions. The Wall of Fame program aims to instill pride in Konawaena High School and to encourage and motivate students to set and reach their highest goals and dreams.

Wall of Fame Criteria:

Any student, alumni or friend of Konawaena High School may submit nominations. A candidate for induction into the Konawaena High School Wall of Fame must satisfy the following qualifications:

- Must be a graduate of Konawaena High School either living or deceased.
 - Must have shown that he/she is a person of principles and integrity who will serve as role models for our students.

- Must be eminently distinguished in his or her profession and whose work shall have brought honor and distinction to Konawaena High School; or
 - Must have made a lasting and significant contribution to the betterment of the Kona community.

General Rules:

- More than one nomination may be submitted.
- The Selection Panel will be comprised of:
 - At least one Konawaena Foundation board member
 - At least one Konawaena High School staff member
 - At least one Konawaena High School administrator
- Deadline for submitting nominations shall be March 31 of each school year.
- Maximum number of awardees each year will be limited to two (2).

Recognition:

- The presentation of each year's inductees will be made at the annual Senior Awards recognition ceremony.
- The honoree(s) or their representative will be asked to attend the Senior Awards recognition ceremony.
- A framed photograph and a brief description of the inductee will be placed on the Wall of Honor.
